Description:

In the framework of the WINDINSPIRE project funded by the US NSF (windinspire.jhu.edu), “WindFarms” Symposia has been held every summer since 2013. The first meeting took place at DTU in June of 2013, organized in conjunction with DTU’s Comwind project. A smaller meeting was held at JHU in 2014 and then ‘WindFarms 2015’ at KU Leuven in Belgium. The last meeting, ‘WindFarms 2016’, was held at the University of Texas Dallas in May of 2016. ‘WindFarms 2017’ will here take place as part of WESC, focusing specifically on wind farms, and their design, operation and control. In order to comply with earlier ‘Windfarms’ symposia, oral presentations are ‘invited talk only’, whereas there will be a poster session for anyone wanting to contribute, including undergraduate students associated with the WINDINSPIRE project.
